RESULTS ANNOUNCEMENT–INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR TWO (2) FIXED TERM RESEARCH CONTRACTS WITH REF. NUMBER 1807/35281-20

The results of the candidates' evaluation are hereby announced following the invitation for expression of interest with ref. no. 1807/35281-20/13.10.2020 (ADA: 921Ω469B4M-ΩA4), published within the framework of the European Union funded research project **“TRUSTED, TRACEABLE AND TRANSPARENT ONTOLOGICAL KNOWLEDGE ON BLOCKCHAIN (OntoChain)”**, project code **11330101 (positions code 3301-PR1)**, for the implementation of the project:

“Participation: in the definition of the architecture of the blockchain ecosystem of the European project OntoChain for trustworthy distributed applications [Work Package 3 (WP3)], in the evaluation of the deliverables of the sub-projects of OntoChain on the project's infrastructure and applications [Work Package 4 (WP4)], in the analysis and the evaluation of the incentive mechanisms and business models for the exploitation of this ecosystem [Work Package 5 (WP5)], and in the dissemination activities of the project outcomes [Work Package 7 (WP7)]”

In accordance with the decision of the 68th Meeting of the Research and Management Committee of RC/AUEB of the academic year 2020-2021, dated 02/12/2020 (ADA: ΨΠΝ9469B4M-ΘΩΓ), the application of the following candidate has been selected:

Any objections to the results of the candidates' evaluation should be submitted strictly within a period of five (5) working days from the day following the announcement of the results on the website of RC/AUEB. Candidates who intend to exercise their legal right to the selection process and results, may, upon their written application, request access to the files and supporting documents of other candidates. The files/supporting documents submitted by the candidates are considered as their personal data, within the context of Article 4 of the General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679. Simultaneously, the same documents constitute administrative documents according to Article 5 para. 1 of the Code of Administrative Procedure, if and when they have been taken into account in shaping the relevant assessment procedure. Fulfillment of the right of access is possible under the conditions of the legislation on personal data and article 5 of the Code of Administrative Procedure and in accordance with the conditions that the Personal Data Protection Authority permanently accepts (ΑΠΔΠΧ 28/2018). Before submitting the data to the applicants, it is possible to inform the persons to whom this information refers. If the aforementioned deadline of the objections is not met, the results of this call for expression of interest shall become final.
