RESULTS ANNOUNCEMENT–INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR A FIXED TERM RESEARCH CONTRACT WITH REF. NUMBER 1807/42433-21

The results of the candidates' evaluation are hereby announced following the invitation for expression of interest with ref. no 1807/42433-21/12.11.2021 (ADA: ΨΘΙΨ469B4M-5ΩΣ), published within the framework of the European Union funded research project **"SMART WATER FUTURES: DESIGNING THE NEXT GENERATION OF URBAN DRINKING WATER SYSTEMS-WATER FUTURES"**, project code 11336601 (position code 3366-PR4), for the implementation of the project:
