RESULTS ANNOUNCEMENT–INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR A FIXED TERM RESEARCH CONTRACT WITH REF. NUMBER 1807/42485-21

The results of the candidates' evaluation are hereby announced following the invitation for expression of interest with ref. no 1807/42485-21/12.11.2021 (ADA: 62X7469B4M-E1Σ), published within the framework of the European Union funded research project "ADVANCING BLACK SEA RESEARCH AND INNOVATION TO CO-DEVELOP BLUE GROWTH WITHIN RESILIENT ECOSYSTEMS - BRIDGE-BS", project code 11337701 (position code 3377-PR3), for the implementation of the project:

"Statistical analysis of models and evaluation of data. Policy support actions based on scientific results, in the context of work packages: WP1 (Knowledge base for the Black Sea), WP2 (Ecosystem dynamics under Multistressors), WP3 (Resilience for a healthy Black Sea Ecosystem), WP4 (Adaptive Management), WP5 (Smart observations and technologies for tackling Multistressors, boosting innovation and supporting monitoring), WP6 (Socio-economics and social innovations), WP7 (Accelerating 'Industry 4.0' business models), WP8 (Science-based policy making for Blue Growth), WP9 (Education and Capacity Building), and WP10 (Coordination and Management)"

The files/supporting documents submitted by the candidates are considered as their personal data, within the context of Article 4 of the General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679. Simultaneously, the same documents constitute administrative documents according to Article 5 para. 1 of the Code of Administrative Procedure, if and when they have been taken into account in shaping the relevant assessment procedure. Fulfillment of the right of access is possible under the conditions of the legislation on personal data and article 5 of the Code of Administrative Procedure and in accordance with the conditions that the Personal Data Protection Authority permanently accepts (ΑΠΔΠΧ 28/2018).
