RESULTS ANNOUNCEMENT–INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR A FIXED TERM RESEARCH CONTRACT WITH REF. NUMBER 1807/9835-22

Simultaneously, the same documents constitute administrative documents according to Article 5 para. 1 of the Code of Administrative Procedure, if and when they have been taken into account in shaping the relevant assessment procedure. Fulfillment of the right of access is possible under the conditions of the legislation on personal data and article 5 of the Code of Administrative Procedure and in accordance with the conditions that the Personal Data Protection Authority permanently accepts (ΑΠΔΠΧ 28/2018). Before submitting the data to the applicants, it is possible to inform the persons to whom this information refers. If the aforementioned deadline of the objections is not met, the results of this call for expression of interest shall become final.
