RESULTS ANNOUNCEMENT–INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR A FIXED TERM RESEARCH CONTRACT WITH REF. NUMBER 1807/9572-25

The results of the candidates' evaluation are hereby announced following the invitation for expression of interest with ref. no 1807/9572-25/07.03.2025 (ADA: [6N93469B4M-Y04](#)), published within the framework of the European Union funded research project **"SMART WATER FUTURES: DESIGNING THE NEXT GENERATION OF URBAN DRINKING WATER SYSTEMS-WATER FUTURES"**, project code **11336601 (position code 3366-PR15)**, under the supervision of the Scientist Responsible for the project, Professor Phoebe Koundouri, for a Researcher position, for the implementation of the project: *"Analysis of economic models and evaluation of circular economy data, in the context of work packages (WP): WP1 (Optimisation-based Sequencing for Transitioning of Urban Water Systems under Deep Uncertainty), WP2 (Distributed Monitoring and Evolvable Control), WP3 (Explainable Machine Learning to support robust decision making by data-driven technologies), WP4 (Achieving Eudaimonia; a new theoretical and applied sustainable socio-economic framework), and WP5 (Water-Futures Research Toolbox and Case Studies)"*.

Pursuant to the provisions of articles 244 and 245 of Law 4957/2022 "New Horizons in Higher Education Institutions: Enhancing the quality, functionality and connection of H.E.I. with society and other provisions", and in accordance with the decision of the 240th Meeting of the Research Committee of RC/AUEB of the academic year 2024-2025, dated 02/04/2025 (ADA: [9879469B4M-K23](#)), the application of the following candidate has been selected:

Any objections to the results of the candidates' evaluation should be submitted strictly within a period of five (5) days from the day following the announcement of the results on the website of RC/AUEB, and until Tuesday, the 08th of April 2025, at 16:00 (Local Time). Objections should only be submitted by sending an email to the following address: enstaseis-elke@aub.gr, and not later than the aforementioned closure date, otherwise they will not be accepted in order to be assessed. The Objections must be specific under penalty of inadmissibility. Additionally, any Objections to the results of a personal interview or an examination of knowledge or work competence and efficiency skills, will be considered as rejected. Candidates who intend to exercise their legal right to the selection process and results, may, upon their written application, request access to the files and supporting documents of other candidates. The files/supporting documents submitted by the candidates are considered as their personal data, within the context of Article 4 of the General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679. Simultaneously, the same documents constitute administrative documents according to Article 5 para. 1 of the Code of Administrative Procedure, if and when they have been taken into account in shaping the relevant assessment procedure. Fulfillment of the right of access is possible under the conditions of the legislation on personal data and article 5 of the Code of Administrative Procedure and in accordance with the conditions that the Personal Data Protection Authority permanently accepts (ΑΠΔΠΧ 28/2018). Before submitting the data to the applicants, it is possible to inform the persons to whom this information refers. If the aforementioned deadline of the objections is not met, the results of this call for expression of interest shall become final.
